

I. Introduction

1. The subject

The right to use the names of engines: ASz-62IR-16, ASz-62IR-M18, ASz-62IR-M18/K9-BB, AI-14RA, AI-14RDP.

2. The background

Protection of the reputation of WSK "PZL - KALISZ" SA, its products and its customers' best interests.

II. Description

Any repairs, modifications and rebuilding of the engines, must be in compliance with the documentation of the current holder of the type certificate, ie WSK "PZL - KALISZ" S.A.

In view of the fact that unauthorized operating stations and users of engines:

ASZ-62IR-16, ASZ-62IR-M18, ASz-62IR-M18/K9-BB, AI-14RA, AI-14RDP carry out repairs, modifications and rebuilding of the engines without the authorization of the type certificate holder, please be informed that the right to use these engine names: ASZ-62IR-16, ASZ-62IR-M18, ASz-62IR-M18/K9-BB, AI-14RA, AI-14RDP is limited to engines being manufactured, repaired and rebuilt at WSK "PZL - KALISZ" SA as well as at the maintenance stations authorized by the WSK "PZL-Kalisz" SA.

WSK "PZL-Kalisz" SA shall not be liable for unauthorized by WSK "PZL - KALISZ" SA repairs, modifications and rebuilding.

Unauthorized repairs, modifications and rebuilding may endanger the safety of operation.

This Bulletin does apply these engines: ASZ-62IR-16, ASZ-62IR-M18, ASz-62IR-M18/K9-BB, AI-14RA, AI-14RDP manufactured, repaired and rebuilt at WSK "PZL-Kalisz" SA and at authorized by WSK "PZL-Kalisz" SA maintenance stations.
