Safety manager

- Unique focal point for safety management
- May be assisted by additional personnel

Personnel requirements

Definition of safety objectives?

Safety policy = description of overall philosophies
 & principles

AMC1 ORO.GEN.200(a)(2)

 Establish safety objectives and performance standards

GM1 ORO.GEN.200(a)(2)

Statement of intention to maintain and improve safety

ORO.GEN.200(a)(3) Safety Risk Management

Emergency Response Plan (ERP)

Proportionate

AMC1 ORO.GEN.200(a)(3)(g)

Actions to be taken in case of an emergency

Objectives

- Transitions from normal to emergency operations
- Safe continuations/return to normal
- Coordination with ERPs of other Orgs.

ORO.GEN.200(a)(4) Training & Communication

Evaluation of training programmes & syllabi

AMC1 ORO.GEN.200(a)(4)

- Appropriate training
- Record to be kept

GM3 ORO.GEN.130(b)

- List changes requiring prior approval
- Ground personnel training programmes in OM Part D

ORO.GEN.200(a)(4) Training & Communication

Training

Approved training programme

Trainer qualification

Assessed & documented by operator



Scope of activities

- Ops specs describe operator
- Contracted activities

Frequency of internal CM audits?

CM with feedback to accountable manager

Objective

 Ensure effective implementation of corrective actions

Integration of Management Systems

CAMO / AMO

- So far MS not required by Reg.2042/2003
- RMT.0251 to transpose requirements (Opinion in 2016)

• Compliance manager = quality manager




Complex vs. Non-complex

Workforce of > 20 FTEs


Workforce < 20 FTEs but:

- Contracted activities subject to approval (ORO.GEN.205)
- Risk from:
 - PBN, LVO, ETOPS, HHO, HEMS, NVIS, DG
